Prysmian Secures Financing to Support European R&D Plans & Wins HVDC Power Cable Project

The **European Investment Bank (EIB)** and world leader in the energy and telecom cable systems industry, **Prysmian Group**, have finalized financing of €135 million intended to support the Group's 2021 to 2024 R&D plans in Europe. With the support of EIB, Prysmian Group speeds up innovation and undertakes new projects in the areas of ultra-rapid telecom networks and smarter, more sustainable power grids. Specifically, the areas that will benefit from EIB financing are industrial research innovation and experimentation, new products development and digital transformation and sustainability. The new projects fulfil the goals set within Prysmian Group's innovation road map and strategy, strongly oriented towards the support and promotion of digitalization and the energy transition. "Cable technology is a key enabler to face the challenges of digitalization and energy transition," explains **Srini Siripurapu**, Chief R&D and Innovation Officer Prysmian Group.

Prysmian Group has also entered into a Limited Notice to Proceed (LNTP) for the supply of power cables in the context of a landmark HVDC submarine cable project in the Middle East, worth some €220 million. The LNTP was awarded to Prysmian by **Samsung C&T** as part of its EPC consortium with **Jan De Nul Group**. 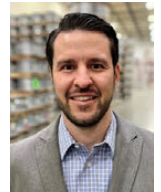

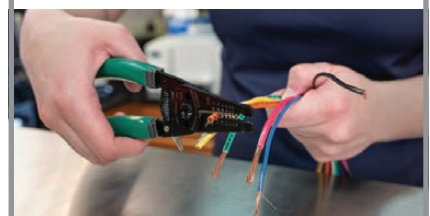

International Wire Group (IWG) Wins US Navy Grant

International Wire Group (IWG), Camden, NY, USA, has won a multi-million-dollar grant from the **US Navy** as part of an initiative to ensure availability of key parts required to support next-generation large guided-missile destroyers. IWG is the top producer of anti-capillary water block-stranded wire to a customer in the critical supply chain, who makes the products used in DDG 51 Class Vessels. IWG has been part of the supply chain for these vessels since the 1980s, selling the bare silicone blocked wire to its customer who insulates/jackets it for Naval applications. IWG's proprietary Anti-Capillary Silicone WaterBlock Strand Wire is designed to defend against water damage, offering protection beyond the water-resistant properties of the cable jacket application for demanding Naval and Marine applications.

IWG will use the award to fund a large-scale project to increase manufacturing capacity to produce the anti-capillary water block strand wire needed within an acceptable lead time. This will ensure no gaps in the critical supply chain for the Navy or any of IWG's other anti-capillary water block strand customers. The project includes purchase of new machinery and infrastructure, and it has a time line completion of 1.5 years.

IWG's proprietary Anti-Capillary Silicone Water-Block Strand Wire is specifically designed to defend against water damage, offering protection beyond the water-resistant properties of the cable jacket application for demanding Naval and Marine applications



Once complete, the expansion will add four times more installed capacity and reduce lead-times by 75%.

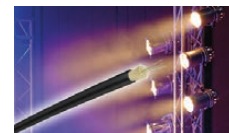

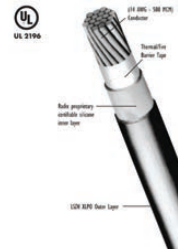

USITC: Existing Duty Orders on Stainless Steel Wire Rod from Asia to Stay in Place

The U.S. International Trade Commission (USITC) has determined that revoking the existing antidumping duty orders on imports of stainless steel wire rod from Japan, Korea and Taiwan would be likely to lead to continuation or recurrence of material injury within a reasonably foreseeable time. As a result, the existing orders on imports of this product from Japan, Korea and Taiwan will remain in place.

Chair **Jason E. Kearns**, Vice Chair **Randolph J. Stayin** and Commissioners **David S. Johanson**, **Rhonda K. Schmidlein**, and **Amy A. Karpel** voted in the affirmative.
